



# 2017 SUMMER KID STOP PROGRAM



All elementary school children entering kindergarten through sixth grade in the fall will be eligible for the 2017 Summer Kid Stop Child Care Program. Summer Kid Stop is located at Gordon L. Willson Elementary School and is available weekdays from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. starting on Monday, June 12 through Friday, August 11th. The Kid Stop Program is a YoungStar program and has an 18:1 student to staff ratio.

**REGISTRATION:** Registration for the Summer Program begins on March 13, 2017. You may register your child/children at the East or GLW Kid Stop sites, or complete the attached 2017 registration form. Please return it to school along with the June tuition and registration fee. One registration form per child, please. Registration forms are available in all elementary school offices, on the District website, and at GLW and East Kid Stop locations. **FEES:** Nonrefundable registration fee - \$15.00 per child  
June tuition - \$195.00 per child  
July tuition - \$235.00 per child (No Kid Stop July 3rd - July 5th )  
August tuition - \$120.00 per child  
Weekly rate - \$80.00/week + reg. fee      **NO DAILY FEE OFFERED.**



*(Fees include daily activities and a PM snack. Field trips are not included in this fee.)*

**FAMILIES RECEIVING CHILD CARE ASSISTANCE** - Families receiving assistance from the County must have a EBT account set up. Families will be charged the above fees. Qualifying families may be responsible for co-pays depending on the rate of pay the county approves for your child's Kid Stop services. You will be billed the first day of each month and payment is due at that time. Please make your payment with your EBT card by calling the number on the back of the card. Once your payment is made it will be posted in the parent portal in Infinite Campus.

**BARABOO SCHOOL DISTRICT SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM** - If your child will be attending summer school and will need Kid Stop services in the afternoon, registration and Kid Stop tuition fees are required. Tuition fees will be the same as the above prices listed.

**FREE FOOD SERVICE PROGRAM STARTING ON MONDAY, JUNE 12th. -**

- Beginning on Monday, June 12th, FREE breakfast (8:15 a.m.-8:45 a.m.) and FREE lunch (11:30 p.m.-12:30 p.m.) will be provided to ALL Kid Stop Kids as part of a Federal-funded program.
  - These meals will be served at GLW and Kid Stop kids are encouraged to take advantage of this free breakfast and lunch program.
  - If your child/children do not participate, a sack lunch and beverage must be provided from home.
- July 13-21: Breakfast and lunch will be served at the Baraboo High School for the Kid Stop Program. (Kid Stop staff will walk the children to the high school and back on these dates.)
  - Please note: sack lunches from home will not be refrigerated or microwaved.
  - This free breakfast/lunch program will end on Friday, July 21st.
- July 24-August 11: A sack lunch and beverage will need to be provided for your child's lunch.

**DAILY PROGRAMMING AND ACTIVITIES:** Children will be involved in a variety of activities including art, reading/library, science, computers, music, gym, swimming, field trips, and much more!

**CLOTHING CHANGE/TOILETRY:** If a Kid Stop child is in need of change of clothing or undergarments, a Kid Stop staff member will call the child's parent/guardian (or their designee) and request a change of clothes be brought to Kid Stop. Furthermore, parents/guardians (or their designee) are responsible for assisting the child in cleanup and changing if needed. The designee must be an authorized contact person who is listed on the child's registration form. Kid Stop staff are not responsible for assisting in toiletry or clothing changes.

**SUMMER KID STOP OPEN SWIM AND SWIM LESSON INFORMATION:** Families may register for Kid Stop Swim Lessons and purchase Kid Stop Pool Passes directly from the indoor pool office. Summer Kid Stop takes frequent field trips to the Baraboo Indoor Pool for open swim. Summer Kid Stop staff also work closely with indoor pool personnel to help children attend swim lessons during their time at Kid Stop. Please see flyer regarding Kid Stop swim lessons and open swims. Sessions fill up quickly, so please register in a timely manner. Purchasing a Kid Stop Pool Pass and/or attending swim lessons is optional.

**Medication/Special Health Needs:** Children who need to take prescription medication will be expected to take their medication outside the Kid Stop environment or have it administered by a parent/guardian. If your child has a special health need, a care plan or written instruction to provide care for your child's special health needs will need to be provided by your physician and reviewed by Kid Stop Staff prior to attending the program.
