Students currently in grades K-5 can choose up to three enrichment courses where they can nurture their love of books, have fun with math and science, or discover the cultures and world around them.

These popular, **FREE** courses will take place at **Al Behrman Elementary** (400 Mulberry St., Baraboo) from **June 12 - July 12**, Monday through Friday (no classes July 3-5) between 8 and 11:30 a.m.

### REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Classes are free and run from 8-9 a.m., 9-10 a.m. and 10:30-11:30 a.m. You may choose to enroll in 1, 2 or 3 classes.

### SUMMER ACADEMY TRANSPORTATION

Summer Academy will provide a shuttle bus to transport students to ABE. The bus will pick up at 7:10 AM at GLW and at 7:25 AM at East. After the third session, the shuttle will leave ABE at noon to drop students off at East at 12:10 PM and at GLW at 12:20 PM. A second shuttle bus will leave ABE around 12:10 and take students to the Boys and Girls Club at 12:20 PM each day. There will not be any home bus pickups/dropoffs during the Summer Academy.

## MAD SCIENTISTS IN OUR MARVELOUS WORLD with PAIGE BAIRD



Each week we will explore different branches of science using technology, literature, math, and STEM activities. Some of these may include Earth Science (paleoecology and oceanography), Life Science (bugs and butterflies), Physical Science (gravitational force and magnets), Biology (our body and 5 senses), and Space Science (astronomy). We will also spend time on math and logic within our science activities.

## CAMPING FUN with CHELSEA BERNIEN



Calling all the explorers and camp lovers! This course is for you. We will experience all the great joys of camping without having to leave the classroom. Math games, songs, reading, crafts, and more! Join us for fun this summer!

## STEM with EMILY CULBERTSON and MICHAEL LUTZ



We will focus on Science, Mathematics, Engineering, and Writing with technological skills. This STEM course will encourage your child to think creatively, learning codes in multiple forms, including iPads and small robots! We will also work on collaborative skills when we build various engineering challenges using materials such as paper, ice cream sticks, etc. Finally, we will record and present our projects using iPads to write and record our learning.

In this fun class K-1 students will explore a new art movement every week. We will learn about each movement of art through reading, writing, discussion and artistic creation. We will be drawing, painting, sculpting and in order to create works of art inspired by artistic movements.
