**Job Description:** The School District of Baraboo is seeking a full-time (40 hours/week) Educational Interpreter for the 2018-2019 school year. The Educational Interpreter provides interpreting and other support services to deaf/hard of hearing students in regular education environments in order to facilitate communication among the deaf/hard of hearing students, hearing peers, and district personnel. Other duties may include instructional reinforcement, note-taking, and participation as a member of the educational team.

**Qualifications:** Candidates should possess a Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction certification (#1348) or other appropriate licensure. In addition, qualified applicants will have the following:

- Knowledge of special education needs and methods.
- Ability to interpret verbal communications to hearing impaired children and adults.
- Ability to work with educational teams.
- Ability to keep records and produce reports.
- Must be able to hold appropriate DPI license.
