Job Title: Elementary Literacy Coach (.5 FTE)
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Job Description: The School District of Baraboo is seeking a dynamic elementary literacy coach to begin with the 2018-19 school year. This elementary literacy coach will collaborate with the district's other literacy coaches to continuously improve student literacy achievement. The Baraboo School District utilizes the Response to Intervention framework as a school improvement process to ensure that all students maximize their potential. Literacy coaches work with students who are in need of support in the area of literacy. In addition, literacy coaches work with classroom teachers on high impact strategies to support the implementation of the Common Core State Standard.

Qualifications: Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction Reading Specialist Certification (#5017) with classroom teaching experience. Candidates with a #1316 certification and willing to obtain #5017 certification are also encouraged to apply. Applicant must serve as an instructional leader and coach by collecting and analyzing student data; facilitating team decision-making around data; identifying needed instructional and evidence-based strategies; modeling best instructional practices; and collaboratively scoring student assessment. Additionally, candidates must have the ability to create trusting relationships that are essential in the coaching role with students, staff, parents, and administration. Preferred candidates will be leaders in the area of Response to Intervention and be proficient in facilitating professional development opportunities for peers.
