### BARABOO SCHOOL BOARD POLICY

#### **458-Rule (2)**

##### Smart Snacks in Schools Overview:

- This is USDA's newest regulation to be enforced in schools that are part of the National School Lunch Program.
- The law specifies that the nutrition standards shall apply to all foods sold outside of the school meal programs on the school campus at any time during the school day. Including: A la Carte programs, in school stores, snack bars, vending machines and onsite fundraisers. These would be considered competitive foods.
- School Campus is defined as all areas of the property under the jurisdiction of the school that are accessible to students during the school day.
- School Day = 30 minutes after the end of the official school day until midnight.
- Fundraisers: The standards would not apply to items sold after the school day, weekends or off campus. A student group may sell foods that do not meet the Smart Snack Standards TWO TIMES per school year during the school day at school.
- No exempt fundraiser foods or beverages may be sold in competition with the school meals.
