

PROCEDURE FOR DETERMINING UNUSUALLY HAZARDOUS AREAS

BARABOO SCHOOL BOARD POLICY

751-Rule (2)

A plan, Policy 751-Exhibit (2), shall be developed by the Director of Business Services (Director) and recommended by the Buildings, Grounds and Transportation Committee (BG&T) for approval by the Board, which shows by map and explanation each area of unusual hazard, a detailed description of the unusual hazard and a solution resolving the situation. Upon approval by the Board, the plan shall be submitted to the Sauk County Sheriff for review and approval. The approved plan shall be filed with the state Department of Public Instruction (DPI), as required by state statute, Ch 121.54(9)(a), Wis. Stats.

The Board shall refer both its own questions and public inquiries concerning existing or potential areas of unusual hazard to the Director of Business Services. He/She shall make recommendations on the designation or declassification of areas of unusual hazard to the BG&T Committee, which shall in turn, recommend action to the Board for review/approval by the county sheriff.

In reviewing existing or potential areas of unusual hazard, or the declassification of an area of unusual hazard, the Director of Business Services, the BG&T Committee and the Board shall be guided by Wisconsin Statutes 121.54(9), PI 7.01 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, or state law and regulations, local law enforcement agencies, the DPI, and any other and further criteria and information that may be of assistance to the Director of Business Services in objectively determining the existence or nonexistence of an area of unusual hazard. The primary supporting documentation shall be this procedure and the written advice of the county sheriff.
