

PUBLIC GIFTS TO THE SCHOOLS

BARABOO SCHOOL BOARD POLICY

840

Gifts from individuals or organizations may be accepted by the District. After receipt of the gift, it shall become the property of the District.

Gifts of \$10,000 or less in approximate value can be accepted and acknowledged by the Director of Business Services or his/her designee without formal Board of Education approval. Gifts of more than \$10,000 may be accepted by the Board upon recommendation of the Director of Business Services.

The School District of Baraboo shall not discriminate in the acceptance and administration of gifts, bequests, scholarships and other aids, benefits or services to students from private agencies, organizations or persons on the basis of sex, race, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
